

#### **Show Rules**

- 1. Exhibiting is open to Club members AND members of the public.
- 2. Maximum of three entries per class.
- 3. Entries **must** be staged by **10.45am**. Late entries after this will not be accepted.
- 4. All entries must be staged in a club vase unless specified.
- 5. Camellias in Classes 22-24 must be staged flat on the table with a stem and two leaves.
- 6. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor (**except** for Floral Art entries).
- 7. You must leave the hall by 10.45am for judging.
- 8. At the end of the show, all exhibitors are expected to
  - collect your exhibits and entry cards from the hall
  - empty all used vases
  - return empty vases to the trolley
- 9. To enter into Class 4. Novice Floral Arrangement exhibitors must be either:
  - Junior level club members or
  - never entered Floral Arrangement in Torbay Garden Club before

#### Points will be awarded as follows:

1st place: 3 points 2nd place: 2 points 3rd place: 1 point Best in Section: 1 point

Class 12. 1 Stem Anemone.

Class 13. 1 Stem Ranunculus.

Class 14. 1 Stem Freesia - any colour - single.

single.

## **SECTION B2:**

- Class 17. 4 Violets, any kind or mixed <u>own container</u>.
- Class 18. 1 bloom not already specified in Sect. B1 or B2 not shrub.
- Class 19. 1 Cluster, truss or spike, not already specified in Sect B1 or B2 **not shrub.**
- Class 20. 1 Spike Orchid, outdoor grown own container.
- Class 21. 2 Stems flowering shrub climber permitted, different kinds.
- Class 22. 2 Stems foliage, different kinds 1 club vase.
- Class 23. 1 vase of garden flowers, not more than 8 stems to be judged on quality and decorative effect foliage optional club container.
- Class 24. Collection of daisy type flowers up to 12 stems club container.
- Class 25. 1 Camellia bloom **small** (under 7cm), named if possible
- Class 26. 1 Camellia bloom **medium** (7-10cm), named if possible
- Class 27. 1 Camellia bloom **large** (over 10cm), named if possible

# Most points in Section B2 - \$20 cash.

#### **SECTION C:**

- Class 28. 3 sticks Rhubarb, with 5cm top and bottom intact.
- Class 29. Collection of 3 different vegetables any kind.
- Class 30. Any other vegetable one specimen.
- Class 31. 4 Herbs, must be named and in water club vase.
- Class 32. 1 Lemon 1cm stalk.
- Class 33. 1 Orange 1cm stalk.
- Class 34. Any other fruit 1 specimen

Most points in Section C - \$20 cash.

The CARLYLE TANKARD will be presented to the Club member with the highest overall points in the Show.

A prize will be awarded to the Champion of the Show.
